

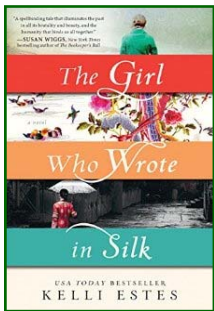

Book discussion groups are for *passionate page-turners* to come together to talk about books and to share a love of reading.

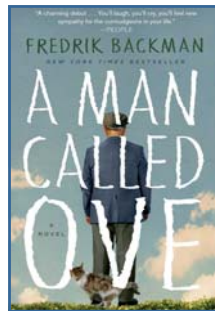
Come and join in the pleasure of discussing four books in the beautiful and informal setting of Nelson, BC.

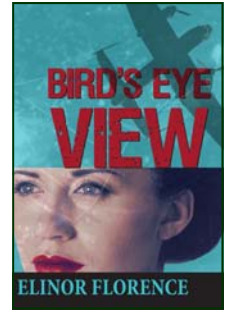
